New path opens through the park

A new path has been opened in time for Christmas so pedestrians and cyclists can cross through the Pukeahu National War Memorial Park site.

It crosses the park just along from Martin Square on one side and the National War Memorial on the other, and is intended as an alternative to crossing at the traffic lights.

The path is beside the central plaza and parade ground which is being paved. As you cross you will have a closer view of the support pillars that are waiting for installation of the Australian War Memorial.

Near Tasman St and Taranaki St, entrance pavilions to the park are rapidly taking shape. At present we are on schedule to complete the park by the end of March.
